

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL  
(Approving and Adopting FY 82 Tribal Budget)

RES. NO. 106-81

1 WHEREAS, the Budget and Finance Committee and the Tribal Accounting Office  
2 did on August 24, 1981, submit to the Papago Tribal Council four  
3 (4) alternative funding levels for the FY 82 tribal budget based  
4 on anticipated revenues of the Papago Tribe, including inter alia  
5 FY 82 Federal Revenue Sharing Funds and/or certain mining royalties  
6 presently allocated to the District IIM accounts pursuant to  
7 Ordinance No. 55; and

8 WHEREAS, the Papago Council did by Resolution No. 103-81, elect not to  
9 allocate either FY 82 Federal Revenue Sharing Funds or additional  
10 mining royalties to the FY 82 tribal budget; and


11 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe anticipates FY 82 general revenues of \$2,052,500.00;  
12 and

13 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has reviewed the proposed FY 82 budgets of the  
14 various departments and tribally funded programs of the Papago  
15 Tribe,

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby  
17 approve and adopt the attached budget totalling \$2,052,500.00  
18 for the Papago Tribe for FY 82, commencing October 1, 1981, and  
19 ending September 30, 1982, and does hereby authorize expenditures  
20 of tribal funds in accordance therewith.


21 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 2nd  
22 day of September, 1981, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote  
23 of 606. for; 542. against; 0 not voting; and 5 absent, pursuant  
24 to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (f) and (h) and  
25 Section 3 (a) and (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the  
26 Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December  
27 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937,  
28 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said  
29 Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent  
30 of the Papago Agency and is subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
