

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(Ordinance No. 25, Re-enacted and Restated,)
(Excluding Sections IV, V, VI and VII.)

RES. NO. 109-81

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Council did on July 10, 1979, by Ordinance No. 04,
2 revoke the 3% sales tax on the sale of livestock produced on the
3 Papago Reservation which was imposed under Ordinance No. 25, on
4 the grounds that "economic conditions of the Papago Tribe (had)
5 improved and the 3% sales tax (was) not necessary;" and
6 WHEREAS, the economic conditions of the Papago Tribe have seriously deter-
7 iorated and the Papago Council did on September 2, 1981, by
8 Resolution No. 104-81, adopt a very restricted tribal budget for
9 FY 82, providing the Livestock Department with an annual budget
10 of \$39,000.00 which is insufficient for the efficient operation
11 of the Department; and
12 WHEREAS, the Papago Council believes that the Reservation livestock industry
13 should help support the tribal programs established for its benefit
14 and that the 3% sales tax imposed on the sale of livestock under
15 Ordinance No. 25 should be reimposed; and
16 WHEREAS, the Papago Council believes that the FY 82 budgets of the Well
17 Maintenance Department and the Enrollment Committee, as provided
18 in Resolution No. 104-81, are also insufficient for their efficient
19 operation.
20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that Ordinance No. 4,
21 enacted on July 10, 1979, is hereby repealed and all of the
22 provisions of Ordinance No. 25, enacted on January 21, 1955,
23 exclusive of Sections IV, V, VI and VII thereof, are hereby
24 re-enacted and restated.
25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that collections of the taxes payable under the
26 restated Ordinance No. 25, shall be paid to the Treasurer of the
27 Papago Tribe and allocated for use by the Livestock Department.
28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the funds allocated to the Livestock Department
29 in the FY 82 tribal budget adopted pursuant to Resolution No. 104-
30 81 be reallocated as follows:
31 \$20,000.00 to the Well Maintenance Department,
32 \$19,000.00 to the Enrollment Committee;

that the Livestock Department budget for FY 82 be established at \$60,000.00, such being the anticipated income from the re-enacted livestock sales tax, and that the respective budgets of the foregoing Departments and Committee be amended to reflect such reallocations.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the FY 82 tribal budget adopted by Resolution No. 104-81 is hereby amended to reflect the foregoing changes.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 3rd day of September, 1981, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 626.5 for; 434.0 against; 87.5 not voting; and 1 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (f), (h) and (m) and Section 3 (a), (e) and (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
