## RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

(Requesting Information Concerning the Setting) (of Traffic Controls on B.I.A. Roads

RES. NO. 124-81

1	WHEREAS,	the representatives from the Hickiwan District submitted evidence to					
2		the Papago Council concerning traffic on the B.I.A. road between Santa					
3		Rosa and Highway 86, establishing (1) that it is being used by trucks					
4		with loads which are too heavy for the road surface and subsurface					
5		resulting in damage to the road; (2) that it is being used by trucks					
6		transporting dangerous substances; and (3) that truck traffic is not					
7		adequately policed and is traveling at excessive speeds; and					
8	WHEREAS,	the Papago Council is concerned about the evidence submitted concerning					
9		the use of such road.					
10	NOW, THE	REFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby request					
11		from the Bureau of Indian Affairs a written opinion concerning the					
12		authority of the Bureau or the Tribe, or both, to control or limit					
13		traffic speed, weight loads and the transportation of dangerous sub-					
14		stances over roads on the Papago Reservation which are built and					
15		maintained by the Bureau of Indian Affairs.					
16	BE IT FU	RTHER RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the Chairman, attorneys and					
17		other appropriate officers of the Papago Tribe are hereby authorized					
18		and directed to review the concerns brought to the Council by the					
19		representatives of the Hickiwan District, to work with the Bureau of					
20		Indian Affairs in order to find solutions to these concerns, and to					
21		bring recommendations to the Council.					
22	The fore	going Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 18th					
23	day of September, 1981, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1107.0 for; 0 against; 41.0 not voting; and 1 absent,						
24		to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (h) and 3 (b), (c) and (i) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the					
25		ribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, d approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant					
26	to Section	on 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is ect to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of					
27	the date	of its enactment by the Papago Council.
