RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

(Appointing a Committee of Three Volunteer) (Council Members to Review Liquor Ordinance)

RES. NO. 125-81

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Council is looking for alternate sources of revenue 2 to support tribal programs; and WHEREAS, the legalization, sale and taxation of alcoholic beverages on 3 the Papago Reservation may be a source for such additional 4 5 revenues; and WHEREAS, the Papago Council has had a proposed liquor ordinance under 6 7 review but has yet failed to act thereon; and WHEREAS, it would be a benefit to the Council to have the proposed 8 9 ordinance reviewed by a committee of Council members, NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby 10 11 appoint a committee of three (3) Council members, consisting of John Narcho, Harriet Toro and Andrew Patricio, to review the 12 proposed liquor ordinance, and within two months, to bring to 13 the Council any recommendations it may have concerning any 14 amendment, implementation, and/or enactment of an ordinance 15 governing the consumption, distribution and sale of alcoholic 16 beverages on the Papago Reservation. 17 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 18th 18 day of September, 1981, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 646.0 for; 374.0 against; 128.0 not voting; and 1 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (e) and 19 (f) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona 20 as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 21 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its 22 enactment by the Papago Council. 23 THE PAPAGO COUNCIL 24
