WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe is a federally recognized Indian Tribe and, WHEREAS, adverse weather conditions has caused severe shortages of livestock feed which seriously threatens the economic existence of the Indian people; and, WHEREAS, there exists an agreement between the U.S. Department of Agriculture and the Department of the Interior to donate feed grain to relieve economic distress or disaster conditions existing among Indian Tribes. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Superintendent of the Papago Agency is requested to help provide the necessary information including the number of livestock affected, range condition or areas affected, precipitation data and other pertinent information to support the intent of this resolution. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Commissioner of Indian Affairs request that the Secretary of Agriculture declare the Reservation of the Papago Tribe of Arizona an acute distress area for the purpose of implementing an Indian Donation Feed Grain Program under the provision of Executive Order No. 11336 and Memorandum of Understanding No. 5 between the Secretary of Agriculture and the Interior. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the donated feed grain will be for Indian-owned subsistence livestock on Indian owned land within the designated acute distress areas.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 4th day of February, 1981, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 965. for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 1 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) and (d) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
