WHEREAS, the Papago Council did by Resolution No. 47-81 appropriate the 1 sum of \$17,500.00 of FY 1981 Federal Revenue Sharing Funds to each 2 of the eleven (11) Districts of the Papago Reservation to be expended 3 by their respective District Councils in accordance with the qualify-4 ing priorities expressed at the public hearings conducted by the 5 Papago Council for such purposes; and 6 WHEREAS, the Sif Oidak District Council has reviewed the District's requests 7 as expressed at such public hearings and has approved a budget for 8 1981 Federal Revenue Sharing Funds appropriated to the Sif Oidak 9 District, as follows: 10 \$5,000.00 to the District's Elderly Program, 11 2,083.35 to the Community of ChuiChu, 12 2,083.33 to the Community of Cockleburr, 13 2,083.33 to the Community of Kohatk, 2,083.33 to the Community of North Komelik, 14 2,083.33 to the Community of Anegam, 15 2,083.33 to Jackrabbit and White Horse Pass jointly; and 16 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has reviewed the District's Federal Revenue 17 Sharing budget and approves of same. 18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby 19 approve the foregoing allocation of the Sif Oidak District of FY 1981 20 Revenue Sharing Funds and authorize the expenditure of these funds 21 by the District's Elderly Program and Communities in accordance with 22 the qualifying priorities expressed at the public hearings conducted 23 by the Papago Council for such purposes. 24 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 8th 25

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 8th day of October, 1981, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1148.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 2 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 3 (a) and (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
