

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL  
(Block Grant Program)

RES. NO. 133-81

1 WHEREAS, the Congress of the United States of America has created a  
2 system of Block Grants to provide federal funding for programs  
3 in the areas of: Alcohol, Drug Abuse and Mental Health;  
4 Primary Care; Health Prevention and Health Services; Community  
5 Services; and Low Income Home Energy Assistance, and;

6 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe has previously provided services for its  
7 members under some of the federal programs which are now  
8 consolidated into these Block Grants, and;

9 WHEREAS, these Block Grants are available directly to Indian tribes  
10 meeting certain eligibility requirements, and;

11 WHEREAS, it would be in the interest of the Papago Tribe to receive  
12 funding for the programs it chooses to pursue directly from  
13 the federal government, rather than indirectly through the  
14 State of Arizona, and;

15 WHEREAS, it is necessary to notify the appropriate federal agencies  
16 of the Papago Tribe's intent to request funds under the  
17 Block Grant Program in order to hold those funds separate  
18 from funds allocated to the State of Arizona, and;

19 WHEREAS, the filing of intent to request funds under the Block Grant  
20 provisions does not obligate the Papago Tribe to apply for  
21 such funds,

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Council does hereby  
23 authorize and direct the Papago Tribal Chairman to file  
24 letters of intent to request funds under the Block Grant  
25 system with the appropriate federal agencies, and;


26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Papago Council does hereby authorize  
27 the Chairman of the Papago Council to develop all plans  
28 and budgets necessary to apply for such funding under the  
29 Block Grant system as is available and will be beneficial  
30 to the Papago Tribe.

31 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all such plans for funding shall be  
32 presented to the Papago Council for approval prior to


submission to the appropriate federal agencies.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 8th day of October, 1981, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1148.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 2 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a), (d), (f), (h) and (m) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
