

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL  
(BIA to Repair Ventana Roadway)

RES. NO. 136-81

1 WHEREAS, the public road to Ventana is a dirt road in bad state of  
2 repair; and

3 WHEREAS, the Hickiwan District Council has voiced its concern that the  
4 road seasonally becomes impassable to community residents and,  
5 more significantly, to school buses, ambulances and to  
6 Community Health Representatives, that students from Ventana  
7 have frequently missed school and that emergency services have  
8 been disrupted because the road has become impassable; and


9 WHEREAS, the B.I.A. has a trust responsibility to provide the residents  
10 of Ventana access both to schools and health services; and

11 WHEREAS, the road could be made into an all-weather road if the B.I.A.  
12 would spread gravel on it.


13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby  
14 urgently request the B.I.A. to provide the necessary repairs  
15 to the roadway to Ventana in order to make it an all-weather  
16 road.

17 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 8th  
18 day of October, 1981, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote  
19 of 1148.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 2 absent,  
20 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (d) of  
21 Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as  
22 amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by  
the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of  
the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to  
review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of  
its enactment by the Papago Council.
