6	Community Health Representatives, that students from Ventana						
7	have frequently missed school and that emergency services have						
8	been disrupted because the road has become impassable; and						
9	WHEREAS, the B.I.A. has a trust responsibility to provide the residents						
10	of Ventana access both to schools and health services; and						
11	WHEREAS, the road could be made into an all-weather road if the B.I.A.						
12	would spread gravel on it.						
13	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby						
14	urgently request the B.I.A. to provide the necessary repairs						
15	to the roadway to Ventana in order to make it an all-weather						
16	road.

21	the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of						
22	its enactment by the Papago Council.
