

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(Drawing Interest from Judgment Funds)

RES. NO. 150-81

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe will be operating under severe budget restrictions
2 as a result of anticipated cuts in FY 1982 Congressional Appropria-
3 tions for the Departments of the Interior and of Health and Human
4 Services; and


5 WHEREAS, the funds appropriated by Congress in settlement of damage and land
6 claims of the Papago Tribe have been and continue to earn interest;
7 and

8 WHEREAS, the best use of the interest earned upon such funds are needed to
9 meet tribal needs which will go unmet as a result of the cuts in
10 congressional appropriations.


11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby re-
12 quest the Secretary of Interior to make interest earned upon the
13 Papago Tribe's judgment funds immediately available for appropria-
14 tion by the Papago Council.

15 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 14th
16 day of December, 1981, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
17 of 712.0 for; 308.0 against; 128.0 not voting; 0 absent, pursuant to
18 the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) and (d) of Article
19 V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended,
20 ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary
21 of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18,
22 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary
23 of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago
24 Council.
