

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL  
(Pisinemo District Revenue Sharing Budget FY 81)

RES. NO. 154-81

1 WHEREAS, the Pisinemo District has been allocated from the Federal  
2 Revenue Sharing funds seventeen thousand five hundred dollars  
3 and no cents (\$17,500.00); and

4 WHEREAS, the Pisinemo District Council recommended that such funds be  
5 used to build inside restrooms for San Jose School and to  
6 purchase roofing materials for District housing; and

7 WHEREAS, the Papago Council concurs with the District Council's  
8 recommendation.

9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the Pisinemo  
10 District will expend the Federal Revenue Sharing funds allocated  
11 to the District for the purpose of building restrooms for the  
12 San Jose School and for purchasing roofing materials for District  
13 housing, as follows:



17 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 21st  
18 day of December, 1981, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote  
19 of 1148.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 0 absent,  
20 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (e), (f)  
21 and (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of  
22 Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and  
23 approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to  
24 Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is  
25 not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as  
26 of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
