9	priation and distribution of funds in the IIM Accounts established							
10	pursuant to Ordinance No. 55; and							
11	WHEREAS, members of the Papago Council feel they need the input of the							
12	people from their respective Districts in order to make a							
13	decision to allow or disallow such requested appropriation and							
14	distribution of funds.							
15	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby							
16	table all outstanding requests to draw from the funds on deposit							
17	in IIM Accounts established by the Papago Council for the benefit of the eleven (11) Districts of the Papago Reservation pursuant

20	The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 21st day of December, 1981, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 654.5 for; 471.5 against; 22.0 not voting; and 0 absent

22	pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2(f) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
