

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(IIM Account)

RES. NO. 156-81

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has authority under the provisions of Section
2 3 (1) of Article V of the Constitution of the Papago Tribe to
3 make distributions of mining revenues received by the Papago
4 Tribe; and

5 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has by Ordinance No. 55, allocated 50% of
6 such revenues to interest bearing IIM Accounts for the benefit
7 of the eleven (11) Districts of the Papago Reservation; and


8 WHEREAS, Tribal Programs, Committees and Districts have requested appro-
9 priation and distribution of funds in the IIM Accounts established
10 pursuant to Ordinance No. 55; and

11 WHEREAS, members of the Papago Council feel they need the input of the
12 people from their respective Districts in order to make a
13 decision to allow or disallow such requested appropriation and
14 distribution of funds.


15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby
16 table all outstanding requests to draw from the funds on deposit
17 in IIM Accounts established by the Papago Council for the benefit
18 of the eleven (11) Districts of the Papago Reservation pursuant
19 to Ordinance No. 55.

20 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 21st
21 day of December, 1981, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a
22 vote of 654.5 for; 471.5 against; 22.0 not voting; and 0 absent,
23 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2(f) of
24 Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as
25 amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by
26 the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of
27 the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to
28 review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of
29 its enactment by the Papago Council.
