

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(San Lucy District Revenue Sharing)


RES. NO. 163-81

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Council did allocate \$17,500.00 of Revenue Sharing
2 funds to the San Lucy District per Resolution No. 47-81; and
3 WHEREAS, the San Lucy District Council did submit a budget approved by
4 the Papago Council per Resolution No. 57-81 for the funds; and
5 WHEREAS, the San Lucy District has completed the projects proposed in
6 their Revenue Sharing budget with a remaining balance in
7 excess of \$7,300.00; and
8 WHEREAS, the San Lucy District Council opted to transfer the balance of
9 their Revenue Sharing funds to help fund the establishment of
10 a permanent health clinic in the District; and
11 WHEREAS, the Papago Council is in agreement with the request of the
12 San Lucy District Council.
13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby
14 approve the request of the San Lucy District Council to transfer
15 the balance of their Revenue Sharing funds to establish a
16 permanent health clinic in San Lucy District.
17 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 22nd
18 day of December, 1981, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
19 of 1121.0 for; 0 against; 27.0 not voting; and 1 absent,
20 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (e), (f)
21 and (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of
22 Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and
23 approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to
24 Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is
25 not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as
26 of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
