2	Indian Affairs (December 15, 1981 letter from Vernon Palmer,						
3	Superintendent) that due to the streamlining, the Bureau programs						
4	and budget the kindergarden buildings and quarters vacant at Kerwo,						
5	Ventana and Covered Wells along with the building at Santa Rosa						
6	currently occupied by Head Start are in excess of the B.I.A.'s						
7	present and foreseeable future needs; and						
8	WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe and the Districts involved have need for these						
9	buildings and are interested in acquiring title to and/or use of						
10	these buildings for Tribal or District purposes.						
11	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Tribal Council does hereby						
12	request that the Title to and/or the use of the buildings mentioned						
13	herein above and in the December 15, 1981 letter from Vernon Palmer,						
14	Superintendent, which is attached hereto and made a part hereof,						
15	be transferred to the Papago Tribe as soon as possible.						
16	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman, Vice Chairman and/or the Secretary						
17	of the Papago Tribe do all things and execute the necessary						
18	instruments and documents to carry out the intent of this Resolution.						
19	The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 30th day of December, 1981, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote						
20	of 1148.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 2 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a), (h)						
21	and (m) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and						
22	approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is						
23	not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
