

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(Appointing Members of Papago Election Board)

RES. NO. 18-81

1 WHEREAS, the Uniform Election Ordinance provides for a Papago Election
2 Board to conduct Tribal elections consisting of five (5)
3 bilingual members of the Papago Tribe who are not candidates
4 for office and are selected by the Papago Council for a term
5 of one year, or until replaced; and


6 WHEREAS, Matilda Juan, Nancy Garcia, Nick Lopez, Alfred Andrews and
7 Edward Encinas were selected to the Board by the Papago Council
8 and have performed their duties well; and

9 WHEREAS, Alfred Andrews and Edward Encinas have resigned from the Board
10 and it is necessary to appoint two successor members.

11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that JONAS ROBLES
12 and PAUL ANDREWS are hereby selected as members of the Papago
13 Election Board in accordance with provisions of the Uniform
14 Election Ordinance, and that MARY LOU WILLIAMS is selected
15 as an alternate in the event either of them should refuse the
16 appointment.

17 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 5th
18 day of February, 1981, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
19 of 965 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 2 absent,
20 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (e) and
21 (f) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of
22 Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and
23 approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to
24 Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is
25 not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as
26 of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
