

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(Requesting and Confirming Appointment of)
(Presiding Judge of Papago Tribal Courts)

RES. NO. 19-81

1 WHEREAS, Section 2 of Chapter I of the Law and Order Code of the Papago
2 Tribe provides that the Papago Tribal Courts shall consist of
3 two regular Judges, and that such Judges "shall be appointed
4 by the Commissioner of Indian Affairs, subject to confirmation
5 by a majority vote of the Papago Council", for a term of two
6 (2) years; and

7 WHEREAS, there is presently appointed only one regular Judge, and it is
8 necessary to appoint a second full time Judge of the Papago
9 Tribal Courts; and


10 WHEREAS, HILDA MANUEL meets all of the qualifications for the position of
11 Presiding Judge of the Papago Tribal Courts; and

12 WHEREAS, the Law and Order Committee has recommended that HILDA MANUEL
13 be appointed to such position.


14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby
15 designate and confirm the appointment of HILDA MANUEL as
16 Presiding Judge of the Papago Tribal Courts for a term of two
17 (2) years from date of appointment, and requests that the
18 Commissioner of Indian Affairs appoint its designee to such position.

19 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 5th
20 day of February, 1981, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
21 of 257.5 for; 190.5 against; 517. not voting; and 1 absent,
22 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (e) and
23 (f) and Section 3 (b) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the
24 Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December
25 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937,
26 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said
27 Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent
28 of the Papago Agency and is subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.


