## RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL (State Justice Workshop)

RES. NO. 21-81

WHEREAS, the Papago Tribal Council has been informed through an oral 1 presentation on February 5, 1981, by the Papago Children's Court 2 Judge, Ned Norris, Jr. and Fred M. Johnson, Administrative 3 Officer for the Children's Court, that there is an initiative 4 being implemented by the Arizona State Justice Planning Agency 5 to Remove Juveniles from Jails on Indian Reservations through 6 the Development of Alternatives to Incarceration, and 7 8 WHEREAS, the Arizona State Justice Planning Agency will conduct its first training session February 10 - 13, 1981, and its purpose 9 is to develop and/or provide specific details to the following; 10 A. National Program Coordinators' Purpose, 11 Goal and Guidelines. 12 B. National Program Coordinators' Planning **Process** 13 C. National Program Coordinators' Phase I Tasks; 1. Need Assessment 14 2. Plan Development 3. Financial Resource Strategy 15 4. Service Inventory 16 17 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribal Council has continued to express the need to 18 explore the development of such alternatives. 19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Tribal Council does hereby 20 authorize Ned Norris, Jr. and Fred M. Johnson to attend and 21 provide input as to the Papago Tribes interest and need to 22 develop Alternatives to Incarceration. 23 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the day of February, 1981, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote 779.0 for; not voting; and of 779.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 4 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (e) and 0 0 24 (f) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of 25 Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
