

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL  
(Closure of Coleman Road)

RES. NO. 29-81

1 WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Pima County, Arizona, did on November  
2 17, 1952, by Proceedings No. 756, attempt to establish a 60'  
3 roadway at a point south of the Ajo-Tucson Highway #86 and the  
4 Section line common to Sections 7 & 8, Township 16 South, Range 9  
5 East, G&SRB&M, known as the Coleman Road, located within the  
6 Schuk Toak District; and  
7 WHEREAS, neither the Schuk Toak District and the residents of the lands  
8 abutting said roadway, nor the Papago Council, were consulted  
9 prior to the attempted establishment of said roadway, and have  
10 never granted their consent or been awarded any form of compensation  
11 for a right-of-way necessary to the establishment, use, operation  
12 and maintenance of the roadway; and  
13 WHEREAS, Southwest Properties, Inc., and other owners of land bordering the  
14 Schuk Toak District are using said roadway without the necessary  
15 consents and right-of-way of the Papago Tribe, and are trespassers  
16 upon lands of the Papago Tribe; and  
17 WHEREAS, the Schuk Toak District Council has reviewed the matter of Coleman  
18 Road with representatives of Southwest Properties, Inc., the Pima  
19 County Attorney's office and of other present users of the roadway,  
20 and with members of its District and has concluded that the District  
21 and its members do not in any way benefit from the establishment  
22 and maintenance of the road, and that its continued use as a roadway  
23 constitutes a nuisance and trespass against Tribal lands; and  
24 WHEREAS, the Schuk Toak District Council has rejected all proposals previously  
25 made to it for the proper establishment of, and for the grant of a  
26 right-of-way for Coleman Road, and objects to the further use and  
27 maintenance of the road.  
28 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it objects to the  
29 further use and maintenance of Coleman Road and does hereby direct  
30 and request the Department of Interior to do everything necessary  
31 and proper to close Coleman Road, and to stop and prevent the  
32 continued nuisance and trespass occasioned by its unlawful use

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
and maintenance as a roadway across Tribal lands.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 5th day of March, 1981, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 965 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 0 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (c) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
