

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(Authorizing Employment of Tribal Lobbyists)

RES.NO. 36-81

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe is faced with significant and imminent problems
2 in the relation to Congress, particularly in the areas of a
3 legislative settlement of its water rights and of proposed federal
4 budget cuts and appropriations for Indian programs; and
5 WHEREAS, the firm of Gerard and Byler Associates has effectively represented
6 the Papago Tribe in its negotiations to reach a legislative
7 settlement of its water rights.

8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby
9 approve the employment of the firm of Gerard and Byler Associates
10 as lobbyists to represent the Papago Tribe before Congress.

11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the Chairman is hereby
12 authorized to negotiate and execute a contract on behalf of the
13 Papago Tribe to employ the firm of Gerard and Byler Associates
14 as lobbyists for the Papago Tribe.


15 BE IT FURTHER RESOVLED by the Papago Council that it does hereby direct
16 the Chairman to find the necessary funds within the administrative
17 budget of the Papago Tribe to cover the expenses of such contract.


18 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 2nd
19 day of April, 1981, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
20 428. for; 65. against; 396. not voting; and 3 absent, pursuant
21 to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a), (e), (f) and
22 (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona
as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by
the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of
the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to
review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its
enactment by the Papago Council.
