

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBE
(Sells District Budget)

RES. NO. 38-81

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Council did by Ordinance No. 03-80 appropriate the
2 sum of \$539,916.72 from the District IIM Accounts established
3 pursuant to Ordinance No. 55, to the Sells District to be
4 expended by the District Council under budgets which must take
5 into consideration the District's funding requirements over
6 the next three years; and

7 WHEREAS, the Sells District Council has reviewed the financial needs and
8 resources of the Sells District and has by Resolution No. 01-81
9 recommended that this years' one-third share of the appropriated
10 funds, or the sum of \$179,972.26, be divided equally among the
11 four communities of Big Fields, Cowlic, Sells and North Villages.


12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby
13 authorize payment from funds appropriated to the Sells District
14 from the District IIM Accounts of the sum of \$44,993.00 to each
15 of the four communities of Big Fields, Cowlic, Sells and North
16 Villages, to be expended by them only, pursuant to budgets duly
17 approved by the governing councils of such communities.

18 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 3rd
19 day of April, 1981, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
20 927 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 2 absent, pursuant to
21 the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 3 (a) of Article V of
22 the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended,
ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the
Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the
Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the
date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject
to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
