RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL (Objecting to Construction of Orme Dam)

RES. NO. 39-81

WHEREAS, Mr. Clinton Pattea, Council Member of the Ft. McDowell Indian 1 Community, made a report to the Papago Council concerning the 2 status of alternative studies for the construction of Orme Dam, 3 on the Ft. McDowell Reservation, and concerning the economic, 4 social and political pressures exerted toward the construction 5 of the Dam; and 6 WHEREAS, members of the Papago Council voiced their strong individual 7 objections against any interference with the right of the Ft. 8 McDowell Indian Community to continue in the peaceful ownership 9 and enjoyment of its traditional homelands. 10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby 11 register its strong objection to the construction of any dam on, 12 or to any interference with the ownership and enjoyment by the 13 Ft. McDowell Indian Community of its traditional homelands, and 14 does hereby fully support the Community in its efforts and actions 15 to save and protect its homelands and the economic base of its 16 people. 17 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 3rd 18 19

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 3rd day of April, 1981, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 965. for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 0 , pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
