

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(Objecting to Construction of Orme Dam)

RES. NO. 39-81


1 WHEREAS, Mr. Clinton Pattea, Council Member of the Ft. McDowell Indian
2 Community, made a report to the Papago Council concerning the
3 status of alternative studies for the construction of Orme Dam
4 on the Ft. McDowell Reservation, and concerning the economic,
5 social and political pressures exerted toward the construction
6 of the Dam; and

7 WHEREAS, members of the Papago Council voiced their strong individual
8 objections against any interference with the right of the Ft.
9 McDowell Indian Community to continue in the peaceful ownership
10 and enjoyment of its traditional homelands.


11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby
12 register its strong objection to the construction of any dam on,
13 or to any interference with the ownership and enjoyment by the
14 Ft. McDowell Indian Community of its traditional homelands, and
15 does hereby fully support the Community in its efforts and actions
16 to save and protect its homelands and the economic base of its
17 people.

18 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 3rd
19 day of April, 1981, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
20 965 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 0, pursuant to the
21 authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) of Article V of the
22 Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified
by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of
the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18,
1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary
of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago
Council.
