


RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(BIA Trailer Transferred to Papago Farms)



1 WHEREAS, the Papago Farms Program does now occupy Universal Trailer No.
2 102, Bureau of Indian Affairs Property No. 454-2190, Serial No.
3 10232; and
4 WHEREAS, it is possible via this Resolution for the trailer to be trans-
5 ferred by B.I.A. to the Tribe for use by the Papago Farms
6 Program; and
7 WHEREAS, said Trailer No. 102, is located at the Papago Farms Headquarters;
8 and
9 WHEREAS, said Trailer is in structually sound condition; and
10 WHEREAS, the Papago Farms Program desires to use the trailer for their
11 program; and
12 WHEREAS, said trailer is no longer used by B.I.A., and is being used by
13 the Papago Farms Program.
14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the following
15 described trailer located at the Papago Farms in Chukut Kuk
16 District, be hereby transferred, assigned, and set over to the
17 Papago Tribe.
18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chairman, Vice Chairman and/or other
19 authorized officials of the Papago Tribe are hereby authorized,
20 on behalf of the Papago Tribe, to receive and receipt for any
21 such facilities transferred or assigned to the Papago Tribe by
22 the Bureau of Indian Affairs pursuant to the request contained
23 in this Resolution.
24 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 15th
25 day of April, 1981, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
26 790.5 for; 130.0 against; 44.5 not voting; and 1 absent, pursuant to
27 the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) of Article V of
28 the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended,
29 ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the
30 Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the
31 Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review
32 by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its
enactment by the Papago Council.
