

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(Authorizing Papago Farming Authority to Contract)

RES. NO. 44-81

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Council did by Resolution No. 72-79, create the Papago
2 Farming Authority in order to study, foster, encourage and promote
3 the economic development of the Papago Tribe and its members by
4 utilization of the agricultural resources of the Papago Reservation,
5 giving unto its Management Board full power to develop, manage,
6 operate, inventory and maintain all tribal farms, agricultural
7 programs and facilities of the Papago Tribe; and
8 WHEREAS, the Management Board of the Papago Farming Authority (Authority)
9 did on March 18, 1981, request that the Papago Council authorize
10 the Authority on behalf of the Papago Tribe to request, apply for,
11 negotiate and execute contracts and grants, and any amendments
12 thereto, directly with the Bureau of Indian Affairs, pursuant to
13 P. L. 93-638, for the maintenance and operation of Vaiva Vo Farms,
14 and for the development, maintenance and operation of Papago
15 Farms; and
16 WHEREAS, the Papago Council finds that the Authority is fully capable of
17 directly managing such contracts and grants, and that it would be
18 to the benefit of the Papago Tribe that the Authority do so.
19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby
20 delegate to the Papago Farming Authority, and to its Management
21 Board and officers in accordance with its Plan of Operation, starting
22 with contracts or grants effective on or after October 1, 1981,
23 and until such time as the Papago Council shall by superceding
24 Resolution revoke such authority, full authority on behalf of the
25 Papago Tribe to request, apply for, negotiate and execute contracts
26 and grants with the Bureau of Indian Affairs, pursuant to P. L.
27 93-638, for the maintenance and operation of Vaiva Vo Farms, and
28 for the development, maintenance and operation of Papago Farms;
29 giving unto the Authority, and its Management Board and officers,
30 full authority, without further review by this Council, to execute
31 such contracts and grants and any amendments thereto, to have
32 direct access to all available records of the Bureau of Indian

1 Affairs, to recontract or renew grants, to request revisions or
 2 amendments to such contracts or grants, to appeal any recommenda-
 3 tions or decisions of the Bureau concerning such contracts or
 4 grants, and to request from the Commissioner of Indian Affairs
 5 waivers under 25 C.F.R. 1.2 of any regulations affecting such
 6 contracts or grants.

7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby authorize
 8 and direct Max H. Norris and Rose Johnson, respectively the
 9 Chairman and Secretary of the Papago Council, to sign and certify,
 10 and do all things necessary to implement the purpose of, this
 11 Resolution.

12 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 15th
 13 day of April, 1981, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
 14 659. for; 109. against; 197. not voting; and 1 absent, pursuant to
 15 the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a), (d), (e) and (f)
 16 of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona
 17 as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved
 18 by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16
 19 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject
 20 to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date
 21 of its enactment by the Papago Council.
