

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(Requesting B.I.A. Assign Locally Based COR)

RES. NO. 45-81

1 WHEREAS, Mr. Tony Felix has reported to the Papago Council that the Bureau
2 of Indian Affairs has appointed a contracting officer's
3 representative ("COR") to administer the Tribe's P. L. 93-638
4 contract for the development, maintenance and operation of
5 Papago Farms whose office is located in Phoenix and who has job
6 assignments in other parts of the State: and

7 WHEREAS, the Papago Council believes that it is impossible for a COR to
8 properly administer a contract, particularly a contract involving
9 a project as distant as Papago Farms, unless such person is
10 assigned directly to the Papago Agency and works in Sells.

11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby
12 request that the Bureau of Indian Affairs appoint a person
13 directly assigned to the Papago Agency as the contracting
14 officers representative to administer the Tribe's P. L. 93-638
15 Papago Farms Contract.

16 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 15th
17 day of April, 1981, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
18 869. for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 2 absent, pursuant to
19 the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) and Section 3 (f)
20 of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona
21 as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved
22 by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16
23 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as
24 of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and
25 is subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
