

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(Authorizing Distribution of FY)
(1981 Revenue Sharing Funds)

RES. NO. 47-81

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe is entitled to receive \$260,667.00 FY 1981 Federal
2 Revenue Sharing funds; and
3 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has conducted two public hearings to determine
4 the greatest needs of the Papago people for the use of such funds.
5 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that, in accordance with
6 priorities expressed at the public hearings had for such purpose, it
7 is hereby directed that distribution of FY 1981 Federal Revenue
8 Sharing funds be made as follows:

23 day of April, 1981, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
512. for; 443. against; 0 not voting; and 0
24 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 3
25 (a) and (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe
26 of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and
27 approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to
Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is
effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago
Agency and is subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.




