

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(Amending Chukut Kuk District Budget)

RES. NO. 48-81

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Council did on September 11, 1980, allocate the sum
2 of \$434,280.84 from the IIM District Accounts to the Chukut Kuk
3 District; and
4 WHEREAS, the Chukut Kuk District Council has previously budgeted \$53,595.00
5 out of the funds so allocated to the District, and by Resolution
6 dated April 11, 1981, has requested that this budget be modified
7 to add \$12,000.00 for youth activities in the communities of San
8 Miguel, New Fields, Vamori and West Villages; and
9 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has heard evidence concerning such request and
10 approves of such requested budget modification.
11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby
12 approve of the foregoing budget modification to increase the
13 District's FY 1981 budget to the sum of \$65,595.00.

14 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 16th
15 day of April, 1981, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
16 965 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 0 absent, pursuant to
17 the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 3 (a) of Article V of
18 the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended,
19 ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the
20 Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the
21 Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the
22 date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject
23 to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
