

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(Appointment of Rodeo and Fair Committee)

RES. NO. 51-81

WHEREAS, the Papago Council did by Resolution No. 82-80 appoint a temporary five (5) member Rodeo and Fair Committee to organize, manage and operate the 1980 Annual Papago Fair, Livestock Show and Rodeo and;

WHEREAS, the Committee performed well and has advised the Papago Council that it is willing to continue to do so on a permanent basis.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby reappoint the following members of the Papago Tribe to the Rodeo and Fair Committee, to organize, manage and operate the annual Papago Fair, Livestock Show and Rodeo, for a period of five (5) years or until replaced by the Council, to-wit:

1. Silas Hendricks
2. Wesley Jose
3. Nathan Pablo
4. Allen Throssell
5. Mark Lopez

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Rodeo Committee shall receive the part time services of a Secretary to be assigned to it by Tribal Administration, and that the Committee account to the Treasurer of the Papago Council for its receipts and disbursements in accordance with procedures to be established by the Treasurer.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 8th day of May, 1981, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 965. for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 1 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (e) and (f) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
