1 WHEREAS, the Indian Action Program provides agricultural, range management  
2 development for members of the Papago Tribe; and

3 WHEREAS, such development will be beneficial to the Papago Tribe and its  
4 people; and


5 WHEREAS, the Indian Technical Assistance Center, Bureau of Indian Affairs,  
6 has made funds available to the Papago Tribe in the amount of  
7 \$25,000.00 as an add-on for Fiscal Year 1981 to continue such  
8 training.

9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Max H. Norris, Chairman, or in his  
10 absence, Enos J. Francisco, Jr., Vice Chairman, or Rosita Ruiz,  
11 Treasurer, be authorized to negotiate and execute this contract  
12 and any amendments thereto for the duration of the contract.


13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the duration of this contract shall be from  
14 July 01, 1981, to September 30, 1981.

15 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 17th  
16 day of June, 1981, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of  
1010.0 for; 0 against; 138.0 not voting; and 0 absent, pursuant  
17 to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) and (d) of  
Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as  
18 amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by  
the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of  
19 the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to  
review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of  
its enactment by the Papago Council.
