1	WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe and the Papago Council wish to develop agriculture,
2	livestock, economy; and
3	WHEREAS, Range Land Development and other livestock operations now
4	functioning need to be improved; and
5	WHEREAS, funds are available for such economic development efforts through
6	P. L. 93-638 grants and contracts with the Bureau of Indian Affairs,
7	Indian Action Team Office in Denver, Colorado; and
8	WHEREAS, it is to the best interest of the Papago Tribe and its people to
9	obtain such grant or contract funding in order to develop these
10	important projects.
11	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that they do request
12	the Bureau of Indian Affairs to execute a contract with the Papago
13	Tribe for the development of the agricultural and livestock economy
14	of this reservation in accordance with the attached work program,
15	staffing and budget requests.
16	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Max H. Norris, Chairman, or in his absence, Enos
17	J. Francisco, Jr., Vice Chairman or Rosita Ruiz, Treasurer, is
18	hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the contract and any
19	amendments thereto during the duration of the contract.
20	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the term of this contract shall begin on October
21	01, 1981, and end on September 30, 1982.
22	The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 17th day of June, 1981, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
23	1038.0 for; 83.0 against; 27.0 not voting; and 0 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) and (d) of Article
24	V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the
25	Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to
26	review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
