BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that if the contracts are not executed by the Bureau of Indian Affairs prior to October Ol, the Papago Tribe will request the Arizona Congressional delegation for an oversite hearing of the Phoenix Area Office.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Papago Tribal Council hereby requests to have all contract negotiations conducted at the Tribal Offices in Sells, Arizona.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Max H. Norris, Chairman, or in his absence, Enos

J. Francisco, Jr., Vice Chairman, or Rosita Ruiz, Treasurer, is

hereby authorized to negotiate and execute these contracts and any
amendments thereto for the duration of the contracts.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 17th day of June, 1981, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1148.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 0 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) and (d) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
