

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

(P. L. 93-638 Contracts - FY-82)

RES. NO. 67-81

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe of Arizona is presently operating the following
2 programs under FY-81 P. L. 93-638 service contracts with the
3 Bureau of Indian Affairs:

4 Papago Children's Home
5 Papago Agricultural Services
6 Papago Court
7 Papago Enrollment
8 Papago JOM Education
9 Papago Rehabilitation Center
10 Papago Tribal Work Experience Program (TWEPP)
11 Papago Community Education
12 Papago Detention and Dispatching Services
13 Papago Early Childhood Education

14 WHEREAS, such Tribal operations have been successful and beneficial to the
15 Papago Tribe and its people; and

16 WHEREAS, 25 CFR Sec. 271.20 of the Federal Regulations requires that all
17 proposals to recontract under P. L. 93-638 be submitted to the
18 Tribal Council for approval at least 120 days prior to the
19 contract termination; and

20 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribal Council does desire to recontract for provision
21 of these services during FY-82.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does authorize
23 and request the Bureau of Indian Affairs to contract with the
24 Papago Tribe under P. L. 93-638 regulations and procedures for
25 the provision of services titled:

26 Papago Children's Home
27 Papago Agricultural Services
28 Papago Court
29 Papago Enrollment
30 Papago JOM Education
31 Papago Rehabilitation Center
32 Papago Tribal Work Experience Program (TWEPP)
Papago Community Education
Papago Detention and Dispatching Services
Papago Early Childhood Education

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the duration of these contracts shall be from
October 01, 1981 through September 30, 1982.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Papago Tribe will not fund or operate programs for which contracts are requested herewith which have not been negotiated and executed by the Bureau of Indian Affairs prior to the start of the funding year.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that if the contracts are not executed by the Bureau of Indian Affairs prior to October 01, the Papago Tribe will request the Arizona Congressional delegation for an oversight hearing of the Phoenix Area Office.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Papago Tribal Council hereby requests to have all contract negotiations conducted at the Tribal Offices in Sells, Arizona.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Max H. Norris, Chairman, or in his absence, Enos J. Francisco, Jr., Vice Chairman, or Rosita Ruiz, Treasurer, is hereby authorized to negotiate and execute these contracts and any amendments thereto for the duration of the contracts.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 17th day of June, 1981, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1148.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 0 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) and (d) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
