

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

(Sif Oidak District Summer Youth)  
(Employment Program )

RES. NO. 72-81

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Council did by Ordinance No. 03-80, appropriate from  
2 the funds in the District IIM Accounts the sum of \$219,695.00  
3 (representing rental income derived from mining activities carried  
4 on within the Sif Oidak District) and the sum of \$375,594.24,  
5 (representing earned mining income) for the benefit of the Sif  
6 Oidak District, to be expended by the District under budgets or  
7 Resolutions of its Council duly approved by the Papago Council; and  
8 WHEREAS, the Sif Oidak District has approved a budget for the Sif Oidak  
9 District Summer Youth Employment Program for \$37,982.48 which  
10 will serve 42 young people of the District for a six week period  
11 between June 22, 1981 through July 31, 1981; and  
12 WHEREAS, the Papago Council supports the Sif Oidak District Summer Youth  
13 Employment Program.  
14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby  
15 approve the attached budget in the sum of \$37,982.48 for the Sif  
16 Oidak District Summer Youth Employment Program and authorizes the  
17 expenditure thereof from funds appropriated to the Sif Oidak  
18 District pursuant to Ordinance No. 03-80.

19 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 17th  
20 day of June, 1981, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of  
21 1148.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 1 absent, pursuant to  
22 the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 3 (a) of Article V of  
23 the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended,  
24 ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the  
25 Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the  
26 Act of June 19, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the  
27 date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject  
28 to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
