

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

(Chairman to Accept Request or Resign)

RES. NO. 87-81


1 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has been presented with a report and recommen-
2 dations from the Budget and Finance Committee anticipatory to
3 the development of a FY 1982 Tribal Budget, with a request that
4 members of the Council express their priorities on certain
5 budgetary options; and

6 WHEREAS, certain members of the Papago Council believe that the Chairman
7 of the Papago Council has failed to provide the Council with
8 the leadership and sufficient detailed and objective admini-
9 strative advice necessary to develop such budget.


10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the Chairman
11 provide liaison and coordination to the Budget and Finance
12 Committee in monitoring and evaluating ongoing tribal programs
13 and provide detailed and objective advice and recommendations
14 necessary or incidental to the development of a comprehensive
15 and detailed FY 1982 tribal budget and that he be asked to
16 resign his office if he should fail to provide the leadership
17 necessary for such purpose.

18 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 7th
19 day of August, 1981, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
20 of 451.5 for; 494.0 against; 199.5 not voting; and 111.1 absent,
21 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (f) of
22 Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as
23 amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by
24 the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of
25 the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to
26 review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of
27 its enactment by the Papago Council.
