

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

(Request to Recontract P.L. 93-638 with Indian Health Service)
(for Eight (8) Papago Tribal Health Programs for FY 1981-82)

RES. NO. 94-81

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe of Arizona is presently operating the following
2 programs under FY-81 P.L. 93-638 service contracts with the Public
3 Health, Indian Health Service:

4 Coordination of Health Service
(Executive Health Staff Administration)
5 Papago Community Health Representatives
6 Papago Alcoholism and Prevention Program
7 Papago Psychological Services
8 Papago Disease Control Program
9 Papago "Wise Ones" (Elderly) Program
10 Papago Community Action, Community Development,
11 Environmental Health Technicians
12 Papago Nutrition Improvement Program

13 WHEREAS, such Tribal operations have been successful and beneficial to the
14 Papago Tribe and its people; and

15 WHEREAS, 25 CFR Sec. 371.20 of the Federal Regulations require that all
16 proposals to recontract under P.L. 93-638 be submitted to the
17 Tribal Council for approval at least 120 days prior to the
18 contract termination; and

19 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribal Council does desire to recontract for provision
20 of these services during FY 1982.

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Tribal Council that it does
22 authorize and request the Public Health, Indian Health Service
23 to contract with the Papago Tribe under P.L. 93-638 regulations
24 and procedures for the provision of services titled:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the duration of these contracts shall be from
October 01, 1981 through September 30, 1982, unless extended
by mutual agreement of both parties.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Papago Tribe will not fund or operate
programs for which contracts are requested herewith which

1 have not been negotiated and executed by the Indian Health
2 Service prior to the start of the funding year.
3 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Mr. Max H. Norris, Chairman or in his absence,
4 Mr. Enos J. Francisco, Jr., Vice Chairman or Ms. Rosita Ruiz,
5 Treasurer, is hereby authorized to negotiate and execute these
6 contracts and any amendments thereto for the duration of the
7 contracts.

8 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 10th
9 day of August, 1981, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
10 1148.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 1 absent, pursuant
11 to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) and (d) of
12 Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as
13 amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by
14 the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of
15 the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to
16 review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of
17 its enactment by the Papago Council.
