Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.

Mr. Phillip Rivas next qualified applicant be hired as Housing 12 Rehab. worker whose reponsibilities shall include assisting Mr. 13 Pilone in repairing the homes of selected Housing Rehab. applicants. 14 3.
