

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
Approving Amendment of Gu Vo District's 1983 Budget

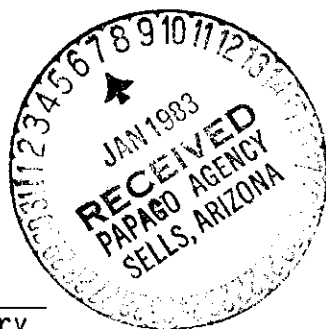
RES. NO. 01-83

1 WHEREAS, the Gu Vo District Council did on November 10, 1982, by Resolution
2 No. 23-82, a copy of which is attached hereto, approve an amendment
3 of the District's 1983 budget and authorize the expenditure of
4 District funds to cover the salaries and fringe benefits of a
5 District Project Housing Officer and Rehabilitation Worker; and
6 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has reviewed the proposed amendment of the
7 District's 1983 budget and has determined that the District has
8 sufficient funds to cover the proposed expenditures.
9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby
10 approve the amendment of the Gu Vo District's 1983 budget as
11 provided in the attached Resolution of the Gu Vo District Council
12 and does hereby authorize expenditure of District funds in
13 accordance therewith.

14 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 6th
15 day of January, 1983, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
16 of 1148.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 2 absent,
17 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 3 (a) of
18 Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as
19 amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by
20 the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of
21 the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of
22 the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is
23 subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.

RESOLUTION OF THE GU-VO DISTRICT COUNCIL
(ACCEPTING HOUSING REHAB. ADHOC COMMITTEE)
(RECOMMENDATIONS.)

RES. NO 23-82

1 WHEREAS, the Gu-Vo District Council did authorize the Housing Rehab. ADHOC
2 Committee to oversee the implementation of the Gu-Vo District Housing
3 Rehab. Program; and

4 WHEREAS, the committee in view of prior concerns of district members as to who
5 will be doing the actual repairs presented the following recommendations:

- 6 1. Mr. Gilbert Pilone, a qualified applicant be hired as Project
7 Housing Officer for a period of eight (8) weeks and at the comp-
8 letion of his eight (8) weeks employment as Project Officer,
9 Mr. Pilones duties will be altered to actual repair work for a
10 period of six (6) months.
- 11 2. Mr. Phillip Rivas next qualified applicant be hired as Housing
12 Rehab. worker whose reponsibilities shall include assisting Mr.
13 Pilone in repairing the homes of selected Housing Rehab. applicants.
- 14 3. Funds be authorized and appropriated from district monies to
15 provide the salaries of above.

23 approve the above recommendations as presented by the AD-HOC Committee.
24 BE IT FURIHUR RESOLVED, that the sum of \$11,648.00 is authorized to be expended
25 from Gu-Vo District funds for the purposes of employing the two (2)
26 positions as described above.
