- That the application of the Local Authority to the Government for a preliminary locan in an amount not to exceed 3% of the Total Development Cost which can be supported by the amount of the ACC for surveys and planning in connection with low-income housing projects of not to exceed approximately 50 dwelling units is hereby approved.
- That there is no objection to the Local Authority's application to HUD for additional housing (a) due to any inconsistency localitites under consideration; or (b) since a definite need for the housing exists even though a Housing Assistance Plan may not be in effect; and (c) since public facilities and services are or will be available and adequate to serve the proposed housing areas mentioned.
