

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
(Approving Application for Preliminary)
(Loan for Low Income Public Housing)

RES. NO. 06-83

1 WHEREAS, it is the policy of this locality to eliminate substandard and
2 other inadequate housing, to prevent the spread of slums and
3 blight, and to realize as soon as feasible the goals of a decent
4 home in a suitable living environment for all of its citizens;
and

5 WHEREAS, under the provisions of the United States Housing Act of 1937,
6 as amended, the United States of America, acting through the
7 Secretary of Housing and Urban Development (herein called the
8 "Government"), is authorized for undermaking and carrying out
preliminary planning of low income housing projects that will
assist in meeting this goal; and

9 WHEREAS, the Act provides that there shall be local determination of need
10 for low income housing to meet needs not being adequately met by
11 private enterprise and that the Government shall not make any
12 contract with a public housing agency for preliminary loans for
13 surveys and planning in respect to any low-income housing projects
14 unless the governing body of the locality involved has by resolution
approved the application of the public housing agency for such
preliminary loan; and

15 WHEREAS, Section 213 of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974
16 provides that the local unit of government be given the opportunity
17 to comment on and/or object to the approval of an application on
18 grounds of inconsistency with local housing assistance planning;
and

19 WHEREAS, the Papago Indian Housing Authority (herein called "Local Authority")
20 is a public housing agency and is applying to the Government for a
21 preliminary loan to cover the cost of surveys and planning in
connection with the development of low-income housing.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council as follows:

- 23 1. That there exists within the jurisdiction of the Papago
24 Council a need for such low-income housing which is not
being met by private enterprise;
- 25 2. That the application of the Local Authority to the
26 Government for a preliminary loan in an amount not
27 to exceed 3% of the Total Development Cost which can
be supported by the amount of the ACC for surveys and
28 planning in connection with low-income housing projects
of not to exceed approximately 50 dwelling units is
hereby approved.
- 29 3. That there is no objection to the Local Authority's
30 application to HUD for additional housing (a) due to
any inconsistency localities under consideration; or
31 (b) since a definite need for the housing exists even
though a Housing Assistance Plan may not be in effect;
and (c) since public facilities and services are or
32 will be available and adequate to serve the proposed
housing areas mentioned.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 6th day of January, 1983, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 712.5 for; 208.5 against; 227.0 not voting; and 4 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) and (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
