

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL  
Submit Health Reorganizational Proposal to Districts

RES. NO. 09-83

1 WHEREAS, the Health Task Force appointed pursuant to Council Resolution  
2 No. 135-82, has submitted to the Papago Council a proposal for  
3 reorganization of the Executive Health Staff; and

4 WHEREAS, the Executive Health Staff has by memorandum dated 01/07/83,  
5 informed the Council that the Health Task Force did not give  
6 them an opportunity to participate in the planning of the proposal  
7 to be submitted for Council consideration; and

8 WHEREAS, the Health Task Force alleges that the Executive Health Staff did  
9 not cooperate with them in their assignment; and

10 WHEREAS, the Papago Council feels that input and comment should be received  
11 from the Papago people who would be directly affected by any  
12 changes made in reorganization of the health programs.

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the proposal  
14 submitted by the Health Task Force be taken back to the respective  
15 Districts for review and comment by them.


16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Papago Council does hereby direct the  
17 members of both the Health Task Force and the Executive Health  
18 Staff to work cooperatively to compromise on a proposal to best  
19 serve the Papago people.

20 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 7th  
21 day of January, 1983, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote  
22 of 1148.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 1 absent,  
23 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (e) and  
24 (f) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of  
25 Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 23, 1936, and  
approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to  
Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is  
not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of  
the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
