

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

P. L. 93-638 Contract FY 1984

RES. NO. 106-83

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe of Arizona is presently operating the  
2 following program under FY 1983 P. L. 93-638 Contract with  
3 the Bureau of Indian Affairs;

Papago Children's Home

4 WHEREAS, such Tribal operation had been successful and beneficial to  
5 the Papago Tribe and its people; and

6 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribal Council does desire to recontract for  
7 provision of these services during FY 1984.

8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does  
9 authorize and request the Bureau of Indian Affairs to contract  
10 with the Papago Tribe under P. L. 93-638 regulations and  
11 procedures for the provision of services titled:

Papago Children's Home

12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the duration of this contract shall be  
13 from October 1, 1983 through September 30, 1984.

14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Papago Tribe will not fund or  
15 operate programs from which contracts are requested herewith  
16 which have not been negotiated and executed by the Bureau of  
17 Indian Affairs prior to the start of the funding year.

18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that if the contract is not executed by the  
19 Bureau of Indian Affairs prior to October 1, 1983, the Papago  
20 Tribal Council will request the Arizona Congressional  
21 delegation for an oversight hearing of the Phoenix Area Office.


22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Papago Tribal Council hereby requests  
23 to have all contract negotiations conducted at the Tribal  
24 Offices in Sells, Arizona.

25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Josiah Moore, Chairman, Francisco Jose,  
26 Jr., Vice-Chairman or Rosita Ruiz, Treasurer, of the Papago  
27 Council is hereby authorized to negotiate and execute this  
28 contract and any amendments hereto for the duration of the  
29 contract.


30 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the  
31 7 day of July, 1983 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a  
32 vote of 1440.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 0  
absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by  
Section 2 (a), (d) and (m) of Article V of the Constitution and by-laws  
of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe  
on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on  
January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934  
(48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the  
Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its  
enactment by the Papago Council.
