1	WHEREAS, Section 104(a) of P.L. 93-638 does authorize the granting of
2	funds for the purpose of "strengthening and improvement of
3	Tribal Government" and
4	WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs has allocated \$254,900.00 of FY 1984 funds for such grant purposes at the Papago Reservation;
5	and
6	WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe does have need to strengthen and develop its
7	Tribal government and management.
8	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Council does request
9	the amount of at least \$254,900.00 for FY 1984 to be budgeted as reviewed and approved by the Tribal Council. Any remaining
10	balance of grant funds will be budgeted for indirect cost.
11	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Josiah N. Moore, Chairman, Francisco
12	Jose Jr., Vice Chairman, or Rosita Ruiz, Treasurer are hereby
13	authorized to negotiate and sign whatever grant documents are required and, further, to negotiate and sign amendments and
14	extensions to such grant.
15	The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the <u>7th</u> day
16	of July, 1983, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of <u>1222.0</u> for; <u>175.5</u> against; <u>53.5</u> not voting; and <u>0</u> absent, pursuant to the
17	authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a), (d) and (m) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as
18	amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
19	of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment
20	by the Papago Council.
