

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
Ordering Employee Compensation

RES. NO. 10-83

1 WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been advised that Muriel Segundo and
2 Julie Carrillo have been successful in their grievance
3 hearings; and

4 WHEREAS, the Tribal Council feels that in order to treat them justly,
5 they should receive the compensation due to them or to which
6 they are entitled; and

7 WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been informed that the Chairman has in
8 a letter dated December 28, 1982, re-instated them to the
9 positions they held before they were terminated; and

10 WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has determined that the provisions of the
11 letter by the Chairman be implemented; and

12 WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is aware that the positions they held are
13 no longer in existence because of funding cuts.


14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Tribal Council that the
15 provisions of the Chairman's letter be implemented and that
16 Muriel Segundo and Julie Carrillo be given first consideration
17 for employment by the Tribe for which they qualify.

18 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 7th
19 day of January, 1983, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
20 of 1148.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 3 absent,
21 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (e) and
22 (f) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of
23 Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 23, 1936, and
24 approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to
25 Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is
26 not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as
27 of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
