

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

Liquor Commission

Res. No. 109-83

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Council did on April 6, 1982, adopt an Ordinance alterna-  
2 tively prohibiting or sanctioning and licensing the introduction,  
3 sale, possession and consumption of alcoholic beverages within the  
4 exterior boundaries of the Papago Reservation; and

5 WHEREAS, the Ordinance requires the appointment of a 3-member Liquor Licenses  
6 and Control Commission; and

7 WHEREAS, the Papago Council feels it is in the Papago Tribe's best interest to  
8 increase the membership to four (4); and

9 WHEREAS, three individuals have expressed an interest in serving as members of  
10 the Liquor Licenses and Control Commission.

11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Council does hereby  
12 amend the above reference Ordinance, Article IV, Section I, to read:  
13 There is created the Liquor Licenses and Control Commission which  
14 shall consist of four members appointed by the Papago Council. One  
15 shall be for a term of four years, one for a term of three years, one  
16 for a term of two years, and one for a term of one year. Thereafter,  
17 all appointments shall be for four years.

18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Papago Council does hereby appoint the  
19 following individuals to the Liquor Licenses and Control Commission  
20 and their terms to be staggered as follows;

21 Harriet Toro, 4 year term


22 Reginald Henderson, 3 year term

23 Kenneth Hart, 2 year term

24 1 member selected from community at large-1 year term

25 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 7th  
26 day of July, 1983 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of  
27 645.0 for; 720.0 against; 75.0 not voting; and 0 absent, pursuant to  
28 the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (e) and 3 (g) of  
29 Article V of the Constitution and by-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as  
30 amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, pursuant to  
31 Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is  
32 effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago  
Agency and is subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.


