

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

Sif Oidak District Budget FY '84

Res. No. 110-83

1 WHEREAS, the Sif Oidak District Council did on June 6, 1983, by Resolution
2 approve the attached FY 83-84 District budget in the amount of
3 \$108,545.60; and

4 WHEREAS, the Sif Oidak District Council has sufficient funds in its IIM
5 Account to cover the projected expenditures; and

6 WHEREAS, the Sif Oidak Council has also advised the Papago Council of its
7 desire to maintain a separate District checking and/or saving
8 account in Casa Grande, at the First Interstate Bank because of
9 the travel distance between Sells and the Sif Oidak District
10 office; and

11 WHEREAS, the District Council has authorized the following officers of
12 the Council to have authority to sign checks on the account:
13 the Chairman, Vice Chairman or the Administrative Secretary;
14 and

15 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has reviewed the projected budget and approves
16 the same; and

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby
18 approve the attached FY 83-84 budget of the Sif Oidak District
19 and authorizes expenditures in accordance therewith; and

20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Papago Council does hereby give authority
21 to the Sif Oidak District to transfer funds on deposit in the
22 District's IIM Account into an account with the First Interstate
23 Bank of Arizona in Casa Grande, an amount not to exceed one half
24 of the total District budget, i.e. \$54,188.80, and the remainder
25 to be transferred when needed to meet the District's budgeted
26 expenses.

27 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 7th
28 day of July, 1983 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
29 1386.5 for; 0 against; 53.5 not voting; and 0 absent, pursuant
30 to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 3 (a) and (h) of
31 Article V of the Constitution and by-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as
32 amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by
the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of
the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of
the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is
subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
