


RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
JOBS BILL/Vaiva Vo Irrigation Project


1 WHEREAS, pursuant to the Emergency Jobs Bill, P. L. 98-8, \$250,000.00 has
2 been appropriated for irrigation construction and improvement
3 at the Vaiva Vo Farms; and
4 WHEREAS, the Vaiva Vo Farms has been surveyed and a scope of work prepared
5 in accordance with the purposes set forth in the Jobs Bill; and
6 WHEREAS, it is in the interest of the Papago Tribe to expedite the project
7 by contracting for the funds pursuant to P. L. 93-638, 25 CFR
8 271.12 and 271.14.
9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Tribe does hereby give notice
10 of its intent to contract for the funds appropriated for the
11 Vaiva Vo Farms by the Emergency Jobs Bill, the term of the contract
12 will be from September 1, 1983, through August 31, 1984.
13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Josiah Moore, Chairman, Francisco Jose, Vice
14 Chairman and Rosita N. Ruiz, Treasurer, of the Papago Council are
15 hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the contract and any
16 amendments thereto on behalf of the Papago Tribe.

17 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 4th
18 day of August, 1983, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
19 of 1440.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 2 absent,
20 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (d), (e)
21 and (f) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of
22 Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and
23 approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to
24 Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is
25 not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as
26 of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
