

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL
HeadStart Program Contract


1 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has consistently supported the idea that
2 education of its young children is vital to their growth and
3 development into responsible, viable members of the Tribe; and
4 WHEREAS, the Department of Health and Human Services has funded and will
5 fund early childhood programs under the HeadStart program; and
6 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe has previously applied for and received funding
7 to operate its HeadStart Programs meeting the criteria established
8 by the Department of Health and Human Services; and
9 WHEREAS, a request and application has been submitted to secure funding
10 for the FY'84 program.

11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Council does hereby support
12 the continued operation of the HeadStart Program and supports the
13 application for FY'84 funding.

14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Josiah Moore, Chairman, Francisco Jose, Vice
15 Chairman or Rosita N. Ruiz, Treasurer, of the Papago Council are
16 authorized to negotiate and execute any and all documents necessary
17 to secure funding for the continued operation of the HeadStart
18 program during the fiscal year 1984.


19 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 4th
20 day of August, 1983, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
21 of 1440.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 3 absent,
22 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) and
23 (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of
24 Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and
25 approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to
26 Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is
27 not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as
28 of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
