

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL  
Housing Improvement Program FY 1984

RES. NO. 116-83

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribal Government established the Papago Skill Center  
2 by Resolution No. 04-79, and O'odham Construction by Resolution  
3 No. 58-80, both are 100% tribally owned and operated; and

4 WHEREAS, the Papago Skill Center has trained 75 Papagos in construction  
5 trades since the Center opened in August, 1981, and proposed  
6 to place its construction trades graduates with the O'odham  
7 Construction; and

8 WHEREAS, the Papago Skill Center has constructed four (4) model homes with  
9 the floor plans and construction techniques that are acceptable  
10 to the Union and the Bureau of Indian Affairs.


11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that it does hereby authorize the Papago  
12 Tribe to enter into a multi-year contract with the Bureau of  
13 Indian Affairs pursuant to 25 CFR 271.12 and 271.14 for the  
14 Housing Improvement Program (HIP). Contract term to be October  
15 01, 1982, through September 30, 1985. The amount available for  
16 FY 1984 is \$336,200.00.

17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the eligibility criteria will be as follows:  
18 each District shall select one (1) participant and (1) alternate  
19 pursuant to 25 CFR 256.5 eligibility.


20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Josiah Moore, Chairman, Francisco Jose, Vice  
21 Chairman or Rosita N. Ruiz, Treasurer of the Papago Council are  
22 hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the contract and any  
23 amendments thereto on behalf of the Papago Tribe.

24 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 4th  
25 day of August, 1983, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote  
26 of 1440.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 2 absent,  
27 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) and  
28 (d) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of  
29 Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and  
30 approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to  
31 Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is  
32 not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as  
of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
