1	WHEREAS, the Papago Council recognizes a need to provide for conservation						
2	and restoration of tribal lands and soils; and						
3	WHEREAS, the Papago Council realizes that a survey will have to be						
4	conducted relating to the character and potential of reservation soils over a period of at least five (5) years; and						
5	WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Branch of Land Operations, has						
	already identified the need for a soil survey to collect date						
6	for use in improving or maintaining the character of rangeland;						
7	and						
8	WHEREAS, the Papago Council recognizes that the soil survey will greatly benefit and enhance any future urban and agricultural develop-						
9	ment of tribal lands.						
10	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Council does hereby request						
11	the Bureau of Indian Affairs to identify funds beginning with						
12	FY '84 through FY '89 to fund a soil survey of the Papago						
13	Reservation. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Bureau of Indian Affairs seek assistance						
	from the USDA Soil Conservation Service to conduct the soil study.						
14	The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 4th						
15	day of August, 1983, at a meeting at which a guorum was present with a vote						
16	6 of <u>635.5</u> for; <u>525.0</u> against; <u>279.5</u> not voting; and <u>2</u> absent pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (d), (e and (f) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and

19	not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
